## The past 12 months

Cheshire and Merseyside ICB is fully established, and staff roles finalised



Warrington had the SEND Inspection; health fully engaged as partners and continue to support going forward



North West independent review into the CAMHS service



Developed the SEND Collaborative Unit (SCU), with a Head of SEND.



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## What have we done?

- Commissioning of ADDvanced Solutions
- Commissioned 'Space to be you' on feedback from parents/carer works alongside CAMHS
- My Happy Mind to primary schools
- Established a 7 day a week mental health drop-in service from the Youth Zone
- Development of the complex needs HUB
- Physiotherapy is fully staffed and waiting time is under 18 weeks
- Recruitment of new ASD nurse
- SALT waiting times are reducing
- Health compliance into the EHC process remains at 99%
