Information about children and young people with SEND is held by different agencies-you asked for joint working with professionals.



- Multi-agency case audits
- TAF meetings joining with annual reviews
- Multi-agency case meetings



The high number of EHC needs assessments means a small number of children and young people are not assessed on time

- Recruitment to the SEND team
- Recruitment to the educational psychology service
- January 2023 18.8% plans issued on time
- January 2024 60.7% plans issued on time



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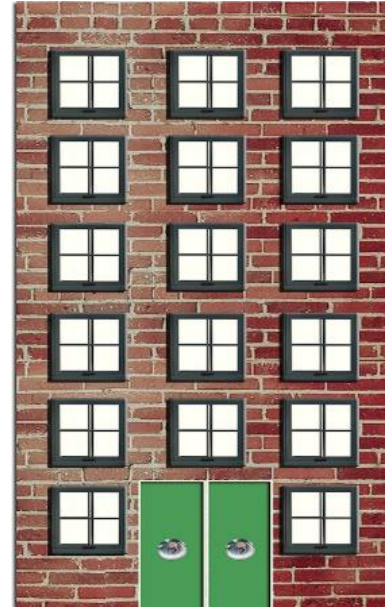
Some annual reviews are not completed on time meaning EHC plans are out of date



- Case workers lead annual reviews
- Amendments made when requested
- Sep 23- Dec 23 79.9% reviews were conducted within statutory timescales.

Warrington needs enough school places to meet the current and future needs of children and young people

- Warrington designated provision places increasing from September 2024
- Graduated increase in placements planned for subsequent years
- Aiming to open a new DP September 2024

- Deliver phase 2 of the Autism in Schools project
